



GET YOUR PENCILS READY! NECKLACE & EARRINGS

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

Bright Colored Pencils (2-3 Sets)
#29494300 Elegance 2 pc. Earring Hoops (2 pk)
#34718005 Silver 48" Flat Link Chain (1 pk)
#34719059 Silver Findings Starter Pack (1 pk)
#61215050 Bright Multi Colored 6/0 E-Beads (1 pk)
Miter Saw (to cut pencils)
Drill (w/ 1.5mm or 1/16" drill bit)
Vise Clamp
Needle Nose Pliers
Round Nose Pliers

Techniques to Know:

Jump Rings
Form a Loop
Cutting Chain
Vise Clamp
Miter Saw
Drilling

DIRECTIONS:

Earring Instructions:

1. Using the safety guard on the miter saw to protect your fingers, cut two 1/4" lengths each, of five different colored pencils.
2. Place cut pencil pieces into vise clamp.
3. Use the drill to drill holes, sideways, through the middle of the pencil lengths.
4. Use needle nose pliers to straighten the bend in the end of an earring hoop. Slide on the following: four different colored e-beads, six different colored pencil pieces, and the matching four different colored e-beads (in reverse order).

5. Use pliers to bend the end of the earring hoop back.
6. Repeat steps 1-5 for the matching earring.

Necklace Instructions:

1. Using the safety guard on the miter saw to protect your fingers, cut three different colored pencils approximately 1 1/2" back from the point on the pencils.
2. Place cut pencils into vise clamp.
3. Use the drill to drill a hole, sideways through the pencils, approximately 2/16" down from the cut end of each pencil.
4. Approximately 3/8" further back than the original bend, use needle nose pliers to bend the end of the earring hoop back. Use round nose pliers to form a loop that meets up with the other end of the earring hoop.
5. Cut chain to desired length.
6. Use a 4mm jump ring to connect a lobster clasp to one end of the chain. Attach a 6mm jump ring to the other end of the chain.
7. Use needle nose pliers to straighten the bend in the end of an earring hoop. Slide on the following: four different colored e-beads, three different colored pencils, and the matching four different colored e-beads (in reverse order) to make a colored pencil accent.
8. Use a 4mm jump ring to attach the loop on top of the accent to the middle of the chain.
