



## Supplies Needed

#34733063 Multi-Colored Bright Multi-Colored Glass Seed Beads, 40 G (1 pk)

#34719059 Silver Findings Starter Pack, 145 pc. (1 pk)

## Tools Needed

Needle Nose Pliers

Round Nose Pliers

Wire Cutters

## INSTRUCTIONS:

1. \*Slide the following seed beads onto individual head pins, trim the ends of the head pins, and form a loop to make the following beaded drops:  
A: 22 black (**make two**)  
B: 3 black, 12 white, 6 black (**make two**)  
C: 3 black, 16 white, 3 black (**make two**)  
D: 3 black, 9 white, 2 black, 3 white, 5 black (**make two**)  
E: 4 black, 5 white, 2 black, 8 white, 3 black (**make one, this is the middle**)
2. Slide the loops of the following beaded drops onto an eye pin, **sliding on one black seed bead in between each one**: A, B, C, D, E, D, C, B, A. Trim the end of the eye pin and form a loop as similar in size and direction as the loop on the other end of the eye pin.
3. Cut two 1 ¼" lengths of extender chain. Use 4mm jump rings to connect one end of each length of chain to the loops on each end of the eye pin from the previous step.
4. Use a 4mm jump ring to join the other end of both lengths of extender chain, together, to the bottom loop of an ear wire.
5. Repeat steps 1-4 for the matching earring.

\*Tip: Seed bead sizes can be a bit irregular. Check the length of each individual beaded drop before forming the loop. You may find you need to add or remove a few beads here and there so the beaded drops are similar in length.

## Pumpkin Seed Bead Earrings

## Supplies Needed

#34733063 Multi-Colored Bright Multi-Colored Glass Seed Beads, 40 G (1 pk)

#34719059 Silver Findings Starter Pack, 145 pc. (1 pk)

#34718005 Silver Curb Chain, 46" (1 pk)

## Tools Needed

Needle Nose Pliers

Round Nose Pliers

Wire Cutters

## Techniques to Know:

Form a Loop

Jump Rings

Cutting Chain

## EARRING INSTRUCTIONS:

6. \*Slide the following seed beads onto individual head pins, trim the ends of the head pins, and form a loop to make the following beaded drops:

A: 3 black, 14 white (make two)

B: 3 black, 3 white, 6 orange, 3 white (make two)

C: 3 black, 2 white, 8 orange, 3 white (make two)

D: 3 black, 1 white, 3 orange, 1 black, 3 orange, 1 black, 2 orange, 2 white (make two)

E: 3 black, 1 white, 2 orange, 1 black, 4 orange, 2 black 1 orange 2 white (make two)

F: 3 black, 1 white, 1 orange, 2 black, 2 orange, 1 black, 1 orange, 1 black, 2 orange, 2 white (make two)

G: 3 black, 1 white, 1 orange, 2 black, 1 orange, 2 black, 4 orange, 2 green (make 1 – this is the middle)

7. Slide the following beaded drops onto an eye pin, **with one black seed bead in between each beaded drop**: A, B, C, D, E, F, G, E, D, C, B, A. Trim the end of the eye pin and form a loop as similar in size and direction as the loop on the other end of the eye pin.

8. Cut two 1 ¼" lengths of extender chain. Use 4mm jump rings to connect one end of each length of chain to the loops on each end of the eye pin from the previous step.

9. Use a 4mm jump ring to join the other end of both lengths of extender chain, together, to the bottom loop of an ear wire.

10. Repeat steps 1-4 for the matching earring.

**NECKLACE INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Repeat steps 1&2 from Earring Instructions.
2. Cut two lengths of chain to desired necklace length.
3. Use 4mm jump rings to connect one end of each chain to each end of the eye pins of the seed bead pumpkin.
4. Use a 4mm jump ring to attach a lobster clasp to the other end of one length of chain. Attach a 6mm jump ring to the end of the other chain.

\*Tip: Seed bead sizes can be a bit irregular. Allow for that variation so all beaded drops are as similar as possible in length before trimming and forming the top loop.
