Techniques to Know

Form a Loop
Jump Rings
Cutting Chain
Crimp Tubes

NECKLACE INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut two 5" lengths of gold extender chain. Attach one 4mm jump ring to one end of each length of chain. Attach a second 4mm jump ring to each of those jump rings.
2. Cut a 12" length of beading wire. Use a crimp tube to connect one end of the beading wire to one of the second jump rings from the previous step. Trim the wire tail.
3. String on a gold e-bead, dark brown natural disk, gold e-bead, and a gemstone bead. Repeat this pattern eight more times, then string on another gold e-bead, dark brown natural disk, and gold e-bead.
4. Use a crimp tube to connect the end of the beading wire to the second 4mm jump ring on the other length of chain from step 1. Trim the wire tail.
5. Attach a 4mm jump ring to the other end of one length of chain. Use another 4mm jump ring to connect a lobster clasp to that 4mm jump ring. Attach a 4mm jump to the end of the other length of chain. Attach a 6mm jump ring to that jump ring. Connect the lobster clasp to the 6mm jump ring.

6. Attach 4mm jump rings to the bottom 4mm jump rings on each side of the necklace. Attach a second 4mm jump ring to each of those jump rings.
7. Cut another 12" length of beading wire. On one side of the necklace, use a crimp tube to connect one end of that length of wire to one of the second 4mm jump rings from the previous step. Trim the wire tail.
8. String on a gold e-bead, dark brown natural disk, and a gold e-bead. Continue stringing on this pattern until you reach a length long enough to drape just above the bead strand from step 3.
9. Use a crimp tube and crimping pliers to attach the end of the beading wire to the second jump ring from step 7 on the other side of the necklace. Trim the wire tail.

BRACELET INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Attach a 4mm jump ring to the loop on a lobster clasp.
2. Cut three 12" lengths of beading wire. Join the wires together, side by side. Use a crimp tube and crimping pliers to attach one end of the joined wires to the 4mm jump ring from the previous step.
3. String the following onto the middle wire: a gold e-bead, dark brown natural disk, and a gold e-bead. Continue this pattern until you reach desired wrist size, ending with a gold e-bead, dark brown natural disk and a gold e-bead.
4. String the following onto each of the two outside beading wires: gold e-bead and a dark brown natural disk. Continue this pattern until you reach the desired wrist size.
5. Join the ends of the three beading wires back together. Use a crimp tube and crimping pliers to attach the three joined wires to a 6mm jump ring. Trim wire tails.
6. Attach the lobster clasp to the 6mm jump ring.

EARRING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Slide the following onto an eye pin: a gold e-bead, dark brown natural disk, gold e-bead, gemstone bead, gold e-bead, and a dark brown natural disk. Trim the end of the eye pin and form a loop to make a beaded link.
2. Attach the gold e-bead side of the bead link to the bottom loop of an ear wire.
3. Slide the following onto a head pin: a gold e-bead, gemstone bead, gold e-bead, dark brown natural disk, and a gold e-bead. Trim the end of the head pin and form a loop to make a bead drop.
4. Attach the loop of the bead drop to the bottom loop of the beaded link.
5. Repeat steps 1-4 for the matching earring.
