*Number and combination of beads varies from package to package. Each package should contain enough beads to make approximately 3-4 napkin rings.

Techniques to Know

Form a Loop

Jump Rings

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Slide a large brown cylinder bead onto an eye pin. Trim the end of the eye pin and form a loop to make a brown bead link.
2. Slide a large green cylinder bead onto an eye pin. Trim the end of the eye pin and form a loop to make a green bead link.
3. Slide a small yellow disk bead, a large yellow oval bead, and a small yellow disk bead onto an eye pin. Trim the end of the eye pin and form a loop to make a bead link.
4. Slide a small charcoal disk bead, a large charcoal oval bead, and a small charcoal disk bead onto an eye pin. Trim the end of the eye pin and form a loop to make a bead link.
5. Slide a brown e-bead, gold e-bead, small green disk, gold e-bead, and brown e-bead onto an eye pin. Trim the end of the eye pin and form a loop to make a bead link. Repeat this step with a small yellow disk in the middle to make another bead link.
6. Slide a gold e-bead, brown e-bead, small charcoal disk, brown e-bead, and gold e-bead onto an eye pin. Trim the end of the eye pin and form a loop to

make a bead link. Repeat this step with a brown disk in the middle to make another bead link.

7. Alternating bead links from steps 1-4 and a bead links from steps 5-6, connect the bead links together to form a ring.
8. Choose one of the larger bead links from steps 1-4 to be the center of your napkin ring. Repeat the other three of those four steps and steps 5-6. Connect those bead links together, as in step 7, beginning and ending with bead links from steps 5-6.
9. Connect the first and last bead link from the previous step to the end loops of the bead link you have chosen to be the middle of your napkin ring.
10. Slide a small green bead, brown e-bead, gold e-bead, and brown e-bead onto a head pin to make a total of four small green bead drops.
11. Repeat step 8, replacing the first bead with small yellow, brown, and charcoal beads to make four small yellow bead drops, four small brown bead drops, and four small charcoal bead drops.
12. Separate the small bead drops into four groups of four, which each include one bead drop of each color. Slide each group of small bead drops onto 6mm jump rings.
13. Choose which bead link in the napkin ring you wish to be on the top middle of the napkin ring.
14. Attach the jump rings on two groups of small bead drops (step 12) to the loop on the left of the top middle bead link on the napkin ring. Repeat this step on the other side of the top middle bead link on the napkin ring.
15. Repeat steps to make number of napkin rings desired. Fold napkins and slide napkin rings onto napkins.
