- Elmer's® Washable Clear Glue (8 oz)
- Water (1/4 Cup)
- Heavy Weight Paper (6")
- Battery Operated Tea Lights (optional)

Tools Needed

- Scissors
- Scotch Tape
- Wax Tip Crystal Applicator or Tweezers (can substitute for Katana, above)
- Plastic or Disposable Bowl
- Thin Disposable Gloves
- Apron (optional but helps protect your clothing)

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut a 6" circle out of heavy paper. Cut that circle in half and form it into a cone tip that fits snugly down over the top of a large

polystyrene cone. Tape the paper cone together and place it on top of the polystyrene cone.

2. Snugly wrap plastic wrap around the polystyrene cone and paper cone top.
3. Lay plastic wrap over work surface to protect it from the glue solution.
4. Choose two packages of cord. Carefully unwrap cords from the header packaging, making sure it doesn't tangle. Cut a small piece of paper off the cord packaging and begin wrapping the cord, from each package, around and around it, into balls. (Taking the time to do this, will help prevent tangling and make the cord much easier to run through the glue solution and apply to the cone.)
5. Mix 8 oz. of glue with 1/4 cup of water. Stir solution until thoroughly mixed.
6. Put on disposable gloves. Begin by running the cord through the glue solution, thoroughly saturating it, and wrapping it around and around the cone and tip. Repeat with second cord. Allow glue to dry thoroughly.
7. Carefully remove the plastic wrapped cone from the Christmas tree.
8. Place the acrylic Christmas tree star down through the top of the Christmas tree.
9. Use katana, wax tip applicator, or tweezers and crystal glue pen to glue flat back crystals onto the Christmas tree. Allow to dry.
10. Repeat steps 1-9 to make a second cone tree.

SUGGESTION: Can place tea lights inside trees to illuminate at night, if desired.
