



## GNOME ORNAMENTS

### Supplies Needed

- #40000664 3" White Pompoms, 4 pc. (1 pk)
- #40000778 1" Multi-colored Pompoms, 40 pc. (1 pk)
- #40000630 Gold .375" Jingle Bells, 18 pc (1 pk)
- \* #47691407 Swarovski Blue Zircon Hot Fix Flatbacks, 30 pc. (1 pk)
- \* #47599141 Swarovski 4mm Light Siam Flatbacks, 28 pc. (1 pk)
- \* #47692107 Swarovski 5mm Dark Moss Green Flatbacks, 20 pc. (1 pk)
- \* #77600100 Swarovski Clear Crystal SS20 Flat Backs, 32 pc. (1 pk)
- #34733002 Brown, Tan Barrel, Circle Wood Bead Mix, 150G (1 pk)
- #65017159 Red/White Cotton Twist Cord, 32.8' (1 pk)

### Tools Needed

- Scissors
- Pencil (for tracing)
- Ruler
- Clear Packing Tape
- Sewing Needle
- White Thread
- Fine Point Paint Brush
- Hot Glue Gun (Adult supervision required)
- Wax Tip Applicator or Tweezers (can substitute for Katana, above)

### Techniques to Know

- Gluing Flatback Crystals
- Basic Sewing
- Double Overhand Knot

### INSTRUCTIONS: (Makes two gnome ornaments)

1. Download and cut out the cone hat pattern on heavyweight paper. (Or, make your own pattern by cutting an 8" circle and cutting that circle into approximately 2/3.)
2. Trace hat pattern onto desired color of foam paper and cut out. Cut a 4" length of clear packing tape. Tape one side of the tape along one of the straight sides of the cut foam

paper. With the tape facing up, bring the other straight side around and press it down onto the tape to form the cone hat. (Optional: Heat up hot glue gun and carefully glue a strip along the seam where the two straight edges meet.)

3. Apply hot glue along the bottom inside edge of the cone hat and press it down onto a large white pompom. Allow the glue to dry.
4. Find a tan barrel bead in the bead mix for a nose. Determine a spot, just below the bottom edge of the hat, and use the needle and thread to sew it onto the large pompom. Trim thread tails.
5. Cut a 6-8" length of red/white twist cord. Fold in half and tie the ends together into a double overhand knot. Cut the very tip of the cone hat back a bit. Place a dab of hot glue down into the top of the hat, slide the overhand knot on the cord down into the hat, and allow to dry.
6. Use needle and thread to sew a jingle bell onto the top of a small white pompom. Trim thread tails. Use hot glue to glue the pompom on top of the hat so the cord is behind it.
7. Use Swarovski crystal glue and katana or wax tip crystal applicator to glue flatbacks onto the cone hat, into desired shapes or designs.
8. Repeat steps 2-7 to make a second gnome ornament.
