



Supplies Needed

- #40000817 Christmas 1" White & Red Tinsel Pompoms, 20 pc. (2 pk)
- #40000865 Cupped 5mm White AB Sequins, 800 pc. (1 pk)
- #40000864 Cupped 5mm Clear AB Sequins, 800 pc. (1 pk)
- #40000867 Cupped 5mm Silver Sequins, 800 pc. (1 pk)
- #40000873 Cupped 5mm Blue Sequins, 800 pc. (1 pk)
- *#37600043 Blue Bead Mat (1) *optional
- #22279004 E6000 & Amazing Quick Hold Craft Glue (1 pk) (or strong holding craft glue)
- Clear Water Bottle w/ Large Screw on Cap (we used 20 oz. bottle w/ blue cap) (1)
- Water (approx. .4% of the total volume of the bottle)
- Clear Washable Craft Glue (approx. .4% of the total volume of the bottle)

Tools Needed

- Scissors
- Measuring Spoons

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Remove bottle wrapping. *Pour approximately 60% of the water from the bottle, leaving approximately 40% of the water in the bottle.
2. *Pour approximately 40% (of the total bottle volume) of glue into the bottle.
3. Add a rounded ½ tsp. of each color of sequins to the bottle.
4. Trim the tinsel off 12 white pompoms, so the remaining tinsel is flush with the surface of the pompoms. (This will prevent sequins from getting stuck in the tinsel.) Add the pompoms to the bottle.
5. Screw the cap on tightly and shake the bottle well. Allow the glitter and pompoms to acclimate to the water/glue mixture. Pompoms will slowly float to the top and sequins should slowly drift to the bottom of the bottle.
6. Experiment with vigorously shaking the bottle and determine if you are happy with the quantity of sequins and pompoms in the bottle. Add more if desired.
7. Dry off the outside of the bottle rim and the inside edge of the cap. Place glue around the outside edge of the rim and screw the cap on. Allow to dry.
8. HAVE FUN!

*Note: Ratio of water to glue can be adjusted, if necessary, to increase or decrease the viscosity (thickness) of the liquid so sequins slowly drift to the bottom.
