Tools Needed

Scissors
Wire Cutters
Needle Nose Pliers
Round Nose Pliers
Crimping Pliers
Round Bottle (approx. 1 ½" in diameter to form wire around)

Techniques to Know

Cutting Wire
Basic Wire Wrap
Form a Loop
Form a Wrapped Loop
Crimp Tubes

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut a 9" length of 20-Gauge gold wire. Use needle nose pliers to hold one end of the wire. Run your fingers along the wire a few times so it will be easier to work with. Form the middle of the wire around the round bottle. Where the ends of the wires cross, twist the wire ends together a couple of times. Form the tails of the wire into a wrapped loop. Trim any excess wire. From here on, the large hoop will be referred to as the earring base. Set aside.
2. Cut an 8" length of stretch cord. String a crimp tube onto one end of the stretch cord. Use needle nose pliers to securely pinch the crimp tube onto the stretch cord. String on a large clear e-bead.
3. Use a big eye beading needle to string on the following: 1" of matte gold seed beads, ¾" of short sparkle bugle beads, and 1" of light gold seed beads to make a beaded strand. (Or create your own combination.) Set aside.

4. Repeat steps 2-3, six more times, to make a total of seven beaded strands.
5. String a crimp tube onto the end of beaded strand. Wrap the end of the stretch cord around the earring base then back down through the crimp tube. Position the tube so it rests just below the earring base. Use crimping pliers to securely close the crimp tube. Trim excess cord tail. Repeat this step with the remaining six beaded strands.
6. Arrange the seven beaded strands so they are centered along the bottom of the earring base.
7. Attach an ear wire to the top loop of your earring.
8. Repeat steps 1-7 for the matching earring.
