



Supplies Needed

#40000925 Self Adhesive Wiggle Eyes, Assorted Sizes 5-15mm, 200 pc. (1 pk)

#40000537 Adhesive Back Stiff Felt, 6x9", 18 pc. (1 pk)

#30002029 Frosted Orange 6/0 E-Beads, 40G (1 pk)

Mason Jar

White School Glue

Unscented or Sensitive Skin Shaving Cream

Saline Solution

Baking Soda

Food Coloring

Tools & Additional Supplies Needed

Scissors

Mixing Bowl and Utensils

¼ tsp. and 1 TB measuring spoons

Printable Monster Face Template (see attached)

Disposable gloves (optional but protect hands & fingers from staining from food coloring)

Instructions:

1. Remove adhesive backing from **same size** wiggle eyes and press together, back-to-back. Repeat until you have glued multiple eyes together (approximately half the package of wiggle eyes, together).
2. Add ½ cup of white school glue and 4 cups shaving cream to bowl. Mix well.
3. *Add drops of food coloring of choice, continuing to stir to mix in color. (Using disposable gloves will prevent hands and fingers from staining.)
4. Stir in ¼ tsp. of baking soda. Then stir in approximately 1 TB of saline solution at time, mixing as you go, adding more saline solution and stirring until the mixture begins to turn into a ball-like form and becomes less sticky.
5. Test the stickiness of the slime mix and add more saline solution if needed.
6. Roll the slime in wiggle eyes (from step #1) and e-beads.
7. Print and cut out monster face template shapes. Trace two eyes, a nose, and a mouth onto the back side of a black piece of adhesive back felt. Cut them out (or create a monster face of your own).
8. Remove adhesive backing and adhere face to the outside of the mason jar.
9. Have fun playing with your slime. When done playing, put slime in mason jar. Store with lid closed to keep fresh. Excess slime can be stored in resealing plastic storage bags.

*Equal drops of red and yellow food coloring will make orange. Equal drops of red (first) then blue food coloring will make purple.)
