



BEADED RIM BOLERO HAT

Supplies Needed

- #61215107 Black Bugle Beads, 33G (1 pk)
- #61215039 Green Glass 11/0 Seed Beads, 40G (1 pk)
- #61215016 Gunmetal Glass 11/0 Seed Beads, 40G (1 pk)
- #69991583 In Bloom Blue Seed/E-Bead/Bugle Bead Assortment (1 pk)

Additional Supplies & Tools Needed

- Invisible Thread
- Small Eye Beading Needle
- Thimble (optional but can be helpful)
- Scissors
- Needle Nose or Bent Nose Pliers
- Downloadable Beading Pattern

Techniques to Know

Overhand Knot

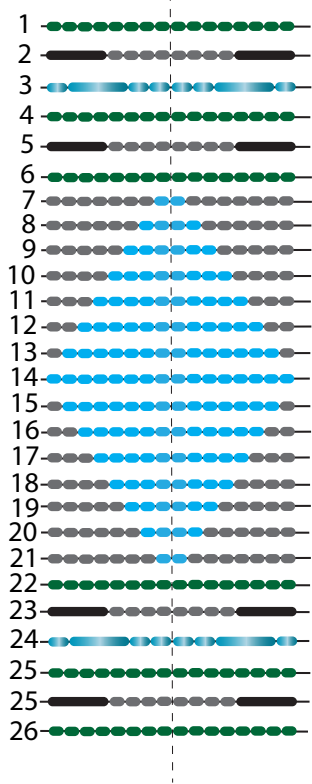
INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Download and print beading pattern (or create your own).
2. Cut a long arm's length of thread, load it onto your beading needle and secure the ends together with a double overhand knot. Trim the tails.
3. Underneath the hat rim, bring the needle and thread through the end of the stitched fold-over of the rim toward the direction of the middle of the hat. Load the first row of beads from the beading pattern onto the needle and thread, slide them down the thread, and up and over the rim. Bring the needle and thread down through the rim.
4. Following the beading pattern, continue stitching rows of beads around the rim of the hat. When the thread gets short, securely knot it underneath the rim and trim thread tails. Load more thread onto the needle and continue stitching around the rim.
5. Repeat until you have stitched beads around the entire hat rim.
